Job Description: The Childcare Assistant provides on-site child supervision for the children of Health Initiatives program participants at our learning centers in North and South Austin. The ideal candidate will have a passion for working with children and delivering educational and enrichment services to vulnerable populations. This position is part-time hourly. Childcare Assistants typically work Monday-Thursday (10am-2pm or 6:30pm-8:30pm) with some variation.

Primary Duties:

- Demonstrate and promote punctuality
- Maintain a safe, clean environment for children from various backgrounds, ages 2 and up
- Establish and maintain on-going communication with parents
- Exhibit a genuine desire to engage children in structured play and learning practices
- Encourage children to partake in educational activities, including homework help
- Assist with room set-up and break-down before and after program

Minimum Qualifications

- High School Diploma or Equivalent, priority given to applicants with coursework in Early Childhood, Education, or related field
- Reliable means of transportation
- Some experience providing educational and/or social services to economically disadvantaged families and working directly with children, especially infants
- CPR/First Aid Certified preferred
- Bilingual (English/Spanish) preferred
