Description

The Cash for College Seasonal Program Specialist is responsible for helping students complete FAFSA/TASFA applications and following up with students and families as necessary.

Job Responsibilities

- Develop knowledge of FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) and TASFA (Texas Application for State Financial Aid) forms and financial aid resources for higher education (paid training is provided)
- Complete FAFSAs/TASFAs and all required financial aid forms for students and parents
- Follow established best practices to ensure a maximum number of clients served accurately
- Ensure student data is accurate, updated, and protected
- Coordinate appointments and on-going support to students and families
- Conduct follow-up activities to prior year and current year students
- Assist with internal and external outreach activities to inform community about services
- Complete income tax and intake training and certification (paid training is provided)
- Participate in staff meetings
- Provide insights, suggestions, and feedback to Program Coordinator
- Perform data entry and other administrative duties as needed
- Other duties & responsibilities as assigned

Basic Qualifications

- Experience providing customer service
- Experience completing the FAFSA or TASFA
- Knowledge of the college financial aid process
- Strong attention to detail
- Ability to speak, read, and write Spanish is highly desired

Requirements

- Travel between sites may be necessary
- Certify through the advanced level of tax preparation (training provided)
- Ability to work in high traffic, noisy community center
