HOUSING

* **CARE TEAMS** 20 Care Teams volunteers are providing social and transportation support by connecting with senior residents at our supportive housing communities either through Care Calls or Shopping Buddies. These programs are integral in helping residents remove barriers and stay connected with their community.

* **SUPPER CLUBS** 1083 volunteers participated in 195 Supper Clubs that helped build community across our Austin properties while also serving 5,100 individual meals to Foundation Communities residents.



* WELCOME HOME BASKETS

Through the support of community sponsors, our Welcome Home Basket program provided over \$28,000 in basic household items to new residents. These baskets filled with necessities provide a warm welcome to the neighborhood and support a fresh start as residents move into their new home at Foundation Communities.

* GROUP SERVICE

411 volunteers gave 1,335 hours working as teams to improve Foundation Communities properties. Many of these projects came with funding support that gave us the opportunity to make property enhancements and save the organization valuable resources.

EDUCATION

* ENGLISH AS A SECOND LANGUAGE

62 volunteers contributed 1,227 hours of classroom assistance for 184 adult students enrolled in our English as a Second Language classes, enabling participants to communicate more effectively with their children's teachers, expand their employment opportunities, and navigate daily life with greater ease.

* LEARNING CENTERS

115 volunteers contributed 2,276 hours to help our 419 students dream big, succeed in school, and maintain a B+ average by assisting them with homework and leading fun enrichment activities across 12 Austin Learning Centers.



HEALTH

* **HEALTH COVERAGE** 126 volunteers gave 2,263 hours and helped complete 4,611 enrolments in 10 weeks, which is a 14% increase compared to last year!

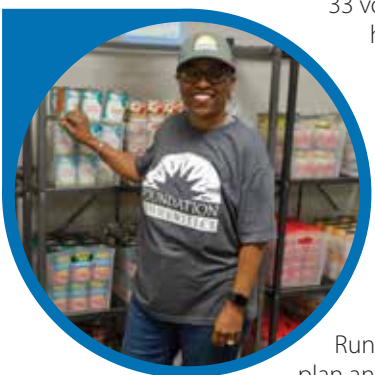
* HEALTHY FOOD PANTRIES

33 volunteers served 846 hours and helped distribute over 362,000 pounds of food at our 14 Healthy Food Pantries this year, serving 9,298 individuals in Austin.

* RUNNING BUDDIES

12 volunteers are supporting kids at Sierra Ridge and Sierra Vista in their running journeys.

Running Buddies help students plan and pace for a race that culminated on April 27!

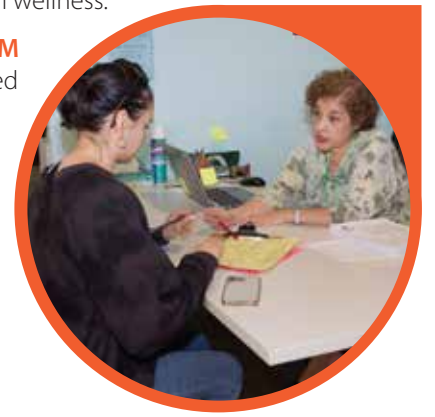


FINANCIAL WELLNESS

* **FINANCIAL COACHING** 41 volunteers spent over 1790 hours meeting one-on-one with 620 individuals –providing the tools and encouragement to create and manage a budget, reduce debt, and improve credit on their path to financial wellness.

* TAX HELP PROGRAM

435 volunteers helped complete more than 15,555 tax returns generating more than \$23 million in refunds for our tax clients.
