


# 2024 OPEN ENROLLMENT **IMPACT REPORT** | NOV 1 – JAN 15

Texas continues to have one of the highest uninsured rates in the country, with many left without coverage as continual enrollment for Medicaid and CHIP ended, affecting hundreds of thousands of applicants. We thank our generous funders, collaborative partners, talented team, and dedicated volunteers who helped Central Texans enroll in affordable health coverage this Open Enrollment season.




**4,691** People Enrolled in Health Coverage

Over **\$30 MILLION** in Advance Premium Tax Credits claimed to make plans more affordable

Of Those Enrolled **212** were enrolled in Medicaid or Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP)

## WHO WE SERVED

**575** were enrolled in Central Health Assistance Program (CHAP), bringing further affordability to low-income Central Texans



**3,882** were served by Prosper Health Coverage for the first time



**44%** speak a language other than English at home

**125** Volunteers donated nearly **2,300** hours of service



Each year, we partner with the Health Alliance for Austin Musicians (HAAM) to help Central Texas musicians enroll in affordable health plans

**2,180** musicians and their families accessed health coverage (Up 4% from last year!)
