Committed to creating pathways to **higher education** and **career advancement**. We accomplish this through free programming that offers holistic support to first-generation, post-traditional or adult learners. Our programs take place across the two **Prosper Centers** and onsite at our **housing communities**.



Classes that help residents and community members increase their use of technological devices, access to the Internet, and additional **digital skill-building**, with the eventual goal of clients upskilling in their careers.



Individual **coaching** and community **workshops** through two "hubs" at our Prosper Centers where we support students with FAFSA or TASFA submission, verification paperwork, scholarship support and planning ahead for **college success**.



A **supportive** program that provides **first-gen** and **adult students** with a **dedicated coach**, matched savings for tuition, emergency funds, and specialized referrals on campus and across the community.





Our English as a Second Language classes support adults with **building English literacy** and **communication** skills. Basic to Advanced classes are offered at our housing communities and virtually.



A **coaching** service for students or community members **searching for employment**. Staff can support individuals with creating a resume or cover letter, applying for jobs, and preparing for interviews.



An initiative that **connects adults** who are interested in advancing within their career or entering into a new line of work with supportive pathways through **credentials or job training**.
