

Children's Home Initiative Program (CHI)

The CHI Program is a 2-year housing and case management program designed to help families build stability and increase their household income. Families receive support from a case manager while working toward personal, financial, career, or education goals. We offer second-chance leasing opportunities for families who may have rental debt, past evictions, or credit challenges.



Families in our program can expect and benefit from:

- ✓ **Stable rent for 2 years**
- ✓ **Weekly support from an on-site case manager**
- ✓ **Help increasing household income**
- ✓ **Financial empowerment classes**
- ✓ **Parent empowerment classes**
- ✓ **Support to reduce debt and build savings**



Basic Eligibility Requirements:

- Household must have at least one minor child
- Must have earned income from employment
- SSI/SSDI, TANF, or Child Support cannot be the only income source
- Must be willing to participate in case management
- Up to 3 evictions/broken leases may be considered (\leq \$1,000 damages per property)
- No recent violent, property, drug, or prostitution-related convictions
